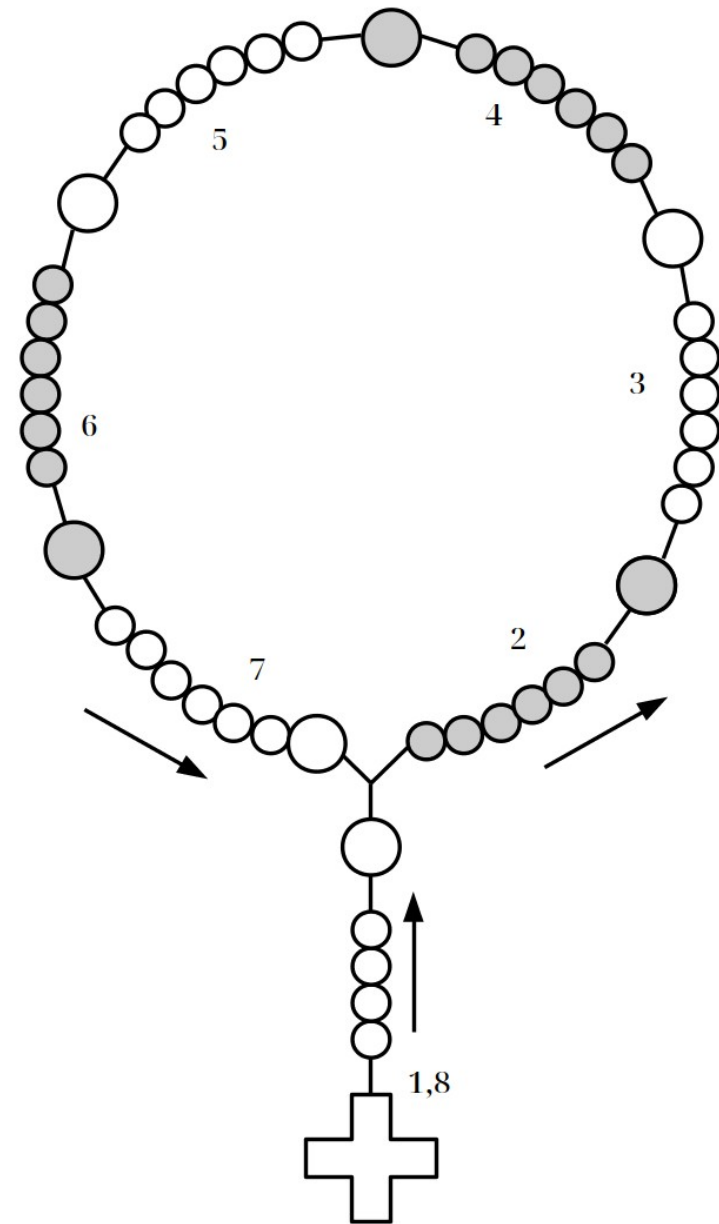

Jn. 3:16 For God so loved the World that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.

Lk. 23:42 Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.

Luther's Morning Prayer I give thanks to you, heavenly Father, through Jesus Christ your dear Son, that you have protected me through the night from all harm and danger. Let your holy angel be with me, so that the wicked foe may have no power over me. Amen.

Gloria Patri Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.

Ten Comm. You shall have no other gods. You shall not make wrongful use of the name of the Lord your God. Remember the sabbath day, and keep it holy. Honor your father and your mother. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or male or female slave, or ox, or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

Phil. 2:11 Every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Words of Inst. In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks, broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying: Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying: This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin.
