

Additional Ideas for Praying with Lutheran Rosary Beads

Intercessory Prayer

- Assign each large bead to a person in your life
- For each small bead, pray for a specific aspect of their life (health, work/school, relationships, etc.)

Weekly Readings

Take your Sunday worship bulletin home with you, and use the prayer of the day, the readings, and the Psalm to select verses for the small and large beads.

Hymns

Assign a phrase from a favorite hymn to the small beads, then pray the whole verse containing that phrase on the large bead.

Themes

Pick a theme for your prayers for a week or a season (guidance, trust, adoration, hope, consolation, etc.). Select short phrases from scripture related to that theme for the small beads, and write a prayer to use for the large beads.

TWO PI

Each “week” of prayers has a theme from the acronym TWO PI: Thanksgiving, Wow (adoration and praise), Oops (confession), Petition (prayers for self), Intercession (prayers for others). The opening beads and the sixth “week” can be prayers of your choice, a phrase of a hymn, or an offering of yourself to God.
